

WHY SHOULD YOU CHOOSE TDM?

The Training in Discipleship & Ministry (TDM) Programme was developed in 2004 through a partnership between the Christian Education Department and the Mission Agency. The programme is geared towards empowering leaders and other church workers for service.

The programmes also offer persons the opportunity to broaden and deepen their Christian faith.

THE PROGRAMME AIMS TO:

- Provide spiritual growth and development for individuals.
- Encourage the spiritual growth of local church leaders and the wider congregation.
- Develop leaders within the local churches.
- Develop a pool of persons who could act as moderators in local churches.



Persons may elect to do the complete programme or selected courses. After completion participants will receive certification.



WHO CAN REGISTER FOR THE PROGRAMME:

- Any church member who has some experience in church activities that involves planning, leading, organizing, teaching.
- Any church member who has served in a leadership capacity in his/her church. e.g. Deacon, Preacher, Sunday School teacher.
- Any member of a church who has sensed God's call for greater service.
- Persons from all denominations wishing to learn more about the Christian faith.
